Zhangjiajie is a world famous tourist city located in the northwest of Hunan province of China. As one of the China's most attractive natural landscape, Zhangjiajie National Forest Park is known especially for its grotesque pillars that are resulted from the weathering of expanding ice in winter and the plants grown on them. In addition, lucid brooks, abundant fauna, and floras are seen throughout the park. The unique pillars from Zhangjiajie also inspired the floating Hallelujah Mountains seen in the movie Avatar (2010).

## **Presentation Guideline**

### ***Oral Presentation***

The official language of the Symposium is English. The time allocations for keynote and invited will be 30 and 15 minutes (including discussion), respectively. Multi-media projector with laptop will be available for presentations. The presentation file should be pre-loaded in the symposium computer 10 minutes before the session begins (The file will be deleted immediately after the presentation).

### ***Poster Presentation***

The poster will be kept in the Symposium Hall from Sept. 2 to 5, 2017. The poster session will be at 19:00 – 21:00, Sept. 3, 2017. At least one author should present in front of his/her poster. A display board with 120 cm high by 90 cm wide will be provided for each poster presentation. The poster can be mounted with adhesive bands, which will be provided at the registration site. Poster presentation should include the title, abstract, main text figures and/or tables, diagrams and conclusions. Please include your contact data (names, institute, address, phone, fax, E-mail). Using color in the poster presentation makes visual communication more effective. Textual and graphic illustrations should be kept simple but effective. Authors or their representative must be in attendance to set-up their display and to present their posters at the session time designated in the scientific program.

### **Notes:**

**NO routine pick-up** at either the airport or train station, please follow the transportation guide to the Hotel. (Pick-up/assistance for massive arrivals or late arrivals in the night might be arranged, especially for those who do not speak Chinese or who need help.)

The **climate** in early September in Zhangjiajie is generally pretty nice with temperature ranging from **20 to 30 °C**. Bringing an Umbrella is recommended. Please mind the slightly humid air in Zhangjiajie.

In the Symposium venue, **free WiFi** will be available.

## Transportation Guide

From **Zhangjiajie Hehua International Airport (张家界荷花国际机场)** to **Dacheng Shanshui Hotel (大成山水国际大酒店)** (about 3.5 km)

Option A: taxi, ~30 RMB, about 10 min

Option B: bus, 1 RMB, about 30 min

Take Bus No. 4 to Yundinghui Station (云顶会站), then walk about 200 meters to **Dacheng Shanshui Hotel (大成山水国际大酒店)**.

From **Zhangjiajie Railway Station (张家界火车站)** to **Dacheng Shanshui Hotel (大成山水国际大酒店)** (about 2.0 km)

Option A: taxi, ~30 RMB, about 6 min

Option B: bus, 1 RMB, about 25 min

Take Bus No. 13 or 10B to **Dacheng Shanshui Hotel (大成山水国际大酒店)**.
